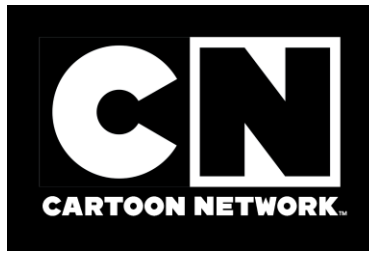

The new Water Park is based on the LEGO Group's newest hit product and the popular cartoon series on Cartoon Network "Legends of Chima", where animal tribes compete in a mystical land for control of the precious energy source called "CHI".

Lion Temple Wave Pool

Lion Temple Wave Pool is the marquee attraction of the new Chima Water Park where guests walk through an 18-foot high Lion Temple Arch created out of more than 260,000 LEGO bricks into an interactive wave pool designed for families with young children. The heart of this wave pool is the 40-foot high Mount Cavora, the floating mountain, known for providing the great energy source "CHI" to the eight animal tribes.

- Lion Temple Wave Pool is 13,000 square feet
- Mt. Cavora stands 40' in height and weighs 11,000 lbs.
- Lion Temple Arch is made out of 260,000 LEGO bricks
- Lion Temple Arch stands 18 ½ feet tall, 14 feet wide and weighs 2,116 lbs.
- 0 feet deep at its entry to 5 feet at its deepest point
- Guests below 42" in height must wear a life jacket and be accompanied by an adult
- Guests below 48" in height must wear a life jacket
- 400 gallons of water pour out of Mt. Cavora every minute

Cragger's Swamp

Cragger's Swamp at LEGO Legends of Chima Water Park includes three slides and more than 50 interactive water features. This hands-on water play area invites guests to ride water slides, blast water cannons and jets and slide through the head of a massive crocodile.

- Cragger's Swamp is 6,650 square feet
- Three water slides: Cragger's Splash, Crug's Run and Cooler's Twist
- 0 feet deep at its entry to 1 feet at its deepest point
- The Throne LEGO model is made out of 38,750 LEGO bricks

Eglor's Build-a-Boat

Following in the unique interactive play experience introduced with Build-A-Raft River at LEGOLAND® Water Park, Eglor's Build-A-Boat gives children the opportunity to use their creativity and bring their imaginations to life as they build their own boat and race against their friends.

- Build-a-Boat river is 35 feet long
- Boat hulls and LEGO bricks are provided for kids to design and build their own boat to race
- A look-out dome allows young guests to peek their head in and watch their boat sail along
- Dam breaks are stationed throughout the river for guests to control and change the flow of the water
- Eglor Eagle Tower LEGO model is made of 125,000 LEGO bricks
- LEGO Models featured throughout the river include:
 - Wolves' Den 1,100 LEGO bricks
 - Lion Fortress 1,950 LEGO bricks
 - Croc Swamp 2,800 LEGO bricks
 - Gorilla Tree 3,500 LEGO bricks
 - Mt. Cavora 7,400 LEGO bricks
